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Introduction

Sam Loy (b.1859 in OH) is a great grandfather of mine. His father, John Loy, came to the USA (OH) in 1853 from Baden. John already had a family, but it appears that his wife, Sophia, did not survive long after arrival. John remarried in the late 1850s to a lady named Susannah Snyder, whose family originated in PA. Susannah is Sam's mother.

This is an attempt to weave a story, consistent with known facts, to explain events associated with the families of John Loy. Along the way I will also explain some potentially confusing or not currently understood facts and some apparent transcription errors.

My goal is to provide a framework that can be built on and revised to arrive at the most accurate history possible, given the nature of the known facts. Future research is also suggested.

Others have written documents that have been helpful. See for example, . . .

Coming Together: Portrait of a Family, by Winona Garmhausen. c.2004, ISBN 978-1-4140-4400-2 (ebook), ISBN 1-4140-4401-1 (paperback). - Winona Garmhausen's book provides a hint that John Loy was married some time before 1846 to a lady whose surname was "Hydaker". Once it occurred to me that this was a corruption of the surname name Heidegger, I was able to build a trail of plausible "evidence" pertaining to their lives in Baden.

Birth Family


I believe that John's name in Baden was actually Johann Georg Lay. Unfortunately, this appears to have been a common name so tracing his records is a little difficult. The location of Göbrichen is a common thread that makes the trace somewhat easier. Current day Göbrichen is just north of Pforsheim as shown on this contemporary map by the red arrow near Neulingen.

A quick summary is that John's father (another Johan Georg Lay) and mother (Christine Klauss) were married in Göbrichen in 1819. John was born in the subsequent year (8/15/1820).

(Another key location later in his life is Würm, indicated by a red pin south of Pforzheim.)



Deeper Ancestry

I have received copies of the Ortssippenbuch for Gobrichen, and I have used the information to construct John's family tree. A researcher with the ID of "tereni" on geneanet.org has compiled quite a bit of information along with source citations as well. (See https://gw.geneanet.org/tereni? lang=en&m=N&v=LAYH .) Following is a summary of some this information in the form of a sketch of descendants of Peter Lay., who is the great grandfather of Johann George Lay (b.1820 - a.k.a. John Loy).

Here is a sketch of some of the descendants of Peter Lay, leading to John Loy (Johann Georg Lay).




Here are the immediate descendants of John's grandfather, Georg Jacob Lay.

John's father is Johann Georg (b.1792).

Many children and grandchildren of Ernst (b.1787), John's uncle, emigrated to the USA. In fact, it appears to me that all children that were living in 1850, except the eldest son Ernst (b.1814), moved from Göbrichen. Some emigrated to America or they had children that emigrated to America. It could be that as eldest son, Ernst took over his father's carpentry business. - The Elder Ernst's unmarried son Gottfried (b.1834) and unmarried daughter Rosina (b.1827) likely traveled to the USA in 1853. They could have traveled with John and his family for all I know. Also contributing to travel to the USA were the families of Barbara (b.1812), Catharina (b.1816), Jacob (b.1821), Georg Adam (b.1825).

The point is that John had cousins from this line in America, as well as possible traveling companions. This may be fertile ground for future research.



Here are the descendants of John's cousin, Mattheaus. [Lay, Matthaeus is the first cousin twice removed (up) of John Loy. Their common ancestors are Lay, Peter and Hoffsaess, Maria.]

There are a number of reasons why offspring of Mattheaus and his wife Margaretha Marquardt are significant to John.


First, John married Matthaeus' daughter Christina (b.1815) in 1843. They had a child that survived less than a year, and the marriage ended in divorce.

Next, it is clear from genetic matching with some of my contemporaries and from various records that Matthaeus' son Jakob (b.1801) immigrated to Crawford County, OH. Various offspring of Jakob have left their mark in the Crawford area. Sister Christina also immigrated with Jacob in 1854.

Jakob's daughter Carolina (b.1838) married Gottleib Ott (b.1837) and their line leads to a person whose DNA matching with me is consistent with the genealogy presented here.

Jakob's daughter Friederika (b.1843) married Martin Suhn and then James Myers and lived in OH.

I wonder if John knew of their presence so close to where he lived.



Early Marriages

John's first marriage was in 1843 to his second cousin, Christina, as mentioned above.

Then, the geneanet.org site also indicates that he may have been married to one Barbara Maier (b.1825), but I have have not looked for supporting evidence of this. The Ortssippnebuch does not mention this marriage.

Then, there is the marriage to Sophia Kaelber.

John's Marriage to Christina Lay

Following is a record of the younger Johann's marriage to Christina Lai in 1843. This means that Johann was married once prior to his marriage with Sophia Kaelber. Also, because of Christina's last name, I wonder if Johann was marrying a cousin.

John's Marriage to Sophia Kaelber

As noted above, John was married to Sophia Kaelber on 2/20/1848 in Würm. ("Deutschland Heiraten, 1558-1929," database, FamilySearch (https://familysearch.org/ark:/61903/1:1:NZM5-92D: 9 March 2018), Johann Georg Lay and Sophia Kaelber, 20 Feb 1848; citing Würm, Baden, Germany; FHL microfilm 1,238,352.) This is slightly later than Winona Garmhausen had estimated in her book, but it seems to fit many facts.

Birth of Mary in OH on 9/26/1853

Some evidence indicates that John's third child, named Mary, age 7, in the 1860 Federal census, was in fact a child of John and Sophia. This reasoning is based on a death record for Mary that follows. It indicates that she was born in OH and that her mother's name was "Sophia Calver", which could be corruption of Sophia Kaelber. Immigration in 1853 supports this. See the Gobrichen Ortssippenbuch.

This leads to the conclusion that Sophia must have made it to the USA, where she gave birth to Mary. It also implies that immigration of the family took place some time prior to 1853 (Mary's birth in OH) and after 1851 (Catherine's birth in Baden). Also, because Sophia does not appear in US records in the 1850s, it is tempting to speculate based on this that she died some time between 1853 and 1857 (when John remarries). More will be said about this later.

Sophia Kaelber and Her First Marriage

Birth and Death

Below are records that describe Sophia's birth and death. They indicate that she was born on 11/1/1820 in Eutingen and that she died on 5/16/1853. The location of her death is not given.

The date of death, however, needs to be considered in light of the birth of the daughter, Mary, who definitely seems to be hers and was born in OH. Here are the key dates that need to be resolved as well as their sources.

- Sophia dies May,1853, according to the German records that follow
- Mary is born in 1853 +/-, according to the 1860 Federal Census
- Mary is born in March, 1854, according to the 1900 Federal Census
- Mary is born in September, 1853, according to her death certificate

So, it would not be unreasonable to assume for now that Sophia died in 1853 and that Mary was born in the same year. Perhaps the birth was associated with the death. This all should be validated through other independent sources, if they exist.



Sophia's First Marriage

To resolve the assertion in W. Garmhausen's book that John's first wife was named "Hydaker", I explored the German records for Sophia in more detail. I did in fact discover that she had been married to one Jakob Friedrich Heidegger in 1842. I have not found a record of Jakob's death, but I suppose that it must have happened after the birth of their son, Wilhelm, in 1846.

Together Sophia and Jakob had four children as follows. (All were born in Würm in Baden.)

- unnamed (b. 1/30/1844, died a few days later)
- Sophia (4/9/1845)
- Friedrich (4/9/1845, survived for nearly one year)
- Wilhelm Martin (11/12/1846)

Evidence for Emigration of Children

I made a quick search of 1860 Federal Census records in Marion Co., OH, for people with the name Heidegger just to see what I would turn up. In fact I found two candidates that appear to match Sophia's surviving children, Sophia and Wilhelm. (This is the county where John Loy and his family appear in 1860.)

These records show what appear to be orphaned children, born in Baden, living in the house of other people from that part of the world.

I suspect that these children lived not too far from John Loy throughout their lives. It is interesting to speculate whether they actually interacted with each other and with John. (By the way, the 1900 Federal Census indicates that Sophia, child of Sophia and Jakob, immigrated in 1853.)

I have discovered some Baden emigration records that likely have bearing on understanding the movements of John and other people with the Lay surname from the Pforzheim area.

This is consistent with transit to the USA in 1853 by Johann Georg (John) Lay. And, this fits nicely with the information that follows regarding immigration and naturalization.

Immigration

As mentioned above, the dates associated with the death of John's wife, Sophia, and the birth of their third child, Mary, indicate that travel between Baden and OH must have taken place some time around 1853. This is a period of time just after the 1848 Revolution in the German states. Much has been written about this, so I just mention it in passing here.

The book noted above by Allen Potts (page 57) does have an intriguing entry for one John Loy, a son John, and daughter Catherine for 1852.

Key pieces of information are the names, birth dates (close, but I believe inaccurate based on other sources), country of origin (Baden), residence in Prospect Township, and immigration in 1852 (for all).

Sophia is not mentioned. This further deepens the mystery surrounding her arrival in the US and the circumstances of the birth of her daughter, Mary.

Naturalization


The Delaware Co. (OH) Records Center provided me with a document from 1858 that may record the naturalization of John Loy. A copy of the document follows. It records the naturalization of seven people – 4 from Ireland and 3 from Germany.

The document is dated 9/28/1858. The names of the seven men are shown in the enlarged insert here.

The three "Germans" are Jacob Koch, William Koch, and John G. Loy/Ley/Lay.

The date of this document would fit well within the time-line described so far. (I understand that during this era, a person would declare his intention to become a citizen and five years later could file final papers to achieve naturalized status.) In other words, arrival in 1852 would allow reasonable time to accomplish naturalization in 1858.



So, this is not definitely a record for John, but it easily could be based on the timing and the location of the court not far from John's residence in Prospect Township.

By the way, a quick bit of research shows that the boundary between Marion and Delaware Counties, which is where John lived, had shifted some years before this. It is possible that Delaware was the preferred location to handle naturalization if you lived near the boundary between the counties, which is where John lived.

Marriage (to Susannah Snyder)

At this point, we have a pretty good case for the fact that John arrived in Prospect Township, Marion Co., OH, in about 1852. His Wife Sophia somehow arrived in the vicinity as well, and their third child (Mary) was born. Sophia dies in 1853. John works as a carpenter, perhaps a skill that he brought from Baden.

This, however, leaves him as single father, supporting three children (Mary, an infant, John, 5 years old, and Catherine, 2 years old). Somehow he made the situation work, but it is not surprising that he would have sought help and companionship. This he found in the person of one Susannah Snyder, who resided with her family in the nearby township of Waldo.

John and Susannah married in March, 1857. By the time of the 1860 Federal Census, their family consisted of John's original three children and two of their own. -

In 1864 they had another daughter, Sarah Ann. - Her 1946 obituary shows her birth date as 2/2/1864.

So, by 1864, there is a family consisting of 6 children, ranging in age from newborn to 16. My great grandfather, Sam was about 5 years old.

At about this time, Susannah no longer appears in records that have been found so far. We will see that the 1870 Federal Census does not show her. Exactly what happens is not at all clear and deserves more research.

Following is a family group chart for the Loy/Snyder family. Note that, where birth locations are found in the historical record for the children, none explicitly show Marion Co., OH, as the place where they were born. Also, note that the family is clearly shown as being in Marion Co. in 1860, however. Perhaps John's work (carpentry) made them a mobile family, or possibly just as likely recorded birth locations reflect inaccurate information and an association with Delphos, OH, which spans Allen and Van Wert Counties.

I have not found the family in 1860 or 1870. It is possible that Susannah's brother, George, became entangled in the Civil War. Her sisters, Martha and Elizabeth, could have married. This would have left parents, John and Catherine, alone and harder to trace. This is another potential future avenue of research that might accidentally reveal something about Susannah's life during the 1860s.

Activities From Mid-1860s Until Death

In this section I investigate some possible events in the life of John Loy. These are "stories" for now until additional corroborating evidence is uncovered.

What does seem certain is that the Loy family (minus Susannah?) moved from the Prospect (Marion County) area to Van Wert county (and Allen county). The cities of Van Wert and Delphos and Lima all seem to be significant in some ways.

Based on what follows, my current best guess is that the Loy/Snyder marriage ended some time between Feb, 1964 and Sept., 1965. This is the time period when I would expect to find death information or divorce information for Susannah. See what you think.

Marriage to Mariah Augustine

Just to confuse the story of John's life, a marriage record exists that might pertain to John. This is not proven, however, and if true the associated date would need to be reconciled with the birth date for Sarah Ann (Feb., 1864) and the fact that Sarah's death certificate says that her mother's name was Schneider (Snyder). Perhaps this marriage is for another John Loy in Marion Co. Many people have picked up on this marriage as fact for "our" John Loy, but I have seen no corroborating evidence.

For now, I choose to view this record as VERY suspicions and doubtful in terms of its applicability to our John Loy. This is another possible area of future research.

Subsequent Marriage to Catherine Klinger Louth

In June, 2018, I contracted with researchers at the Allen Co. Public Library in Ft. Wayne, IN, to see if they could provide some clues regarding what might have happened to Susannah (Snyder) Loy. They were not able to answer that question directly, but they did turn up an interesting fresh twist to somethings that happened to John between the mid-1860s and the time of his death.

They turned up death and burial records for one Mrs. John Loy in Van Wert in 1887. Interestingly, they identified this person as Catherine Klinger, married to Andrew Louth in 1857, and John Lay in 1865. Assuming that this is correct, then John remarried to Catherine Klinger and they were subsequently separated or divorced. (She shows up divorced in the 1880 census.) The sequential evidence trail follows. (This is not a "clean" story and requires support from independent sources.)

1857 marriage of Catherine Klinger to Andrew South (Louth) 3/21/1857.

"South" is probably a transcription error encouraged by the way the letter "L" was written in the original document.





Here is a corresponding news article and some confirming evidence that we are tracking the right person. First an article from the 12/9/1887 "Van Wert Weekly Bulletin". Then a copy of the death certificate for Sophia Barlow, a daughter from the marriage of Catherine to Andrew Louth. Note that Sophia is born in 1859 in Jennings Twp in Van Wert Co. This becomes important later when we look at the 1870 Federal Census.


By the time of the 1870 census, Loy family members would have had the following approximate ages.

- John: 50
- Susannah: 38 (?)
- John: 22 (about to be married to Catherine Parker)
- Catherine: 19 (already married to William Stopher)
- Mary: 17 (within 8 years of marriage to Francis Kopp)
- Christena: 13 (within 7 years of marriage to Andrew Moreo)
- Sam: 11 (within 12 years of marriage to Margaret Rower, 25 years from marriage to Anna Allen)
- Sarah: 6 (within 12 years of marriage to Samuel Archer)

There are two records of interest from the 1870 census. Both confirm that John and family have relocated farther west to the area of Van Wert County. One record from June shows John alone as a carpenter (the expected occupation), but the other may show him and some of his children with another family 2 months later. Here's the first (simple, indisputable) record for the Village of Van Wert.

In this second record, there are some things that make you think that part of the Loy family is present in this household. Namely, . . .

- John Loy has the right age (50), but farming is shown as an occupation not carpentry.
- Mary has about the right age (16 versus 17)
- Christena (Tena) is 13 as expected.
- Sam is the right age (11).
- Sarah is about the right age (7 versus 6).
- Other people are present that do not appear to be part of the original Loy family. Quite possibly this is the family of Catherine Louth (after her divorce/separation from her husband Andrew). This would fit quite nicely with the information proposed by the Allen Co. Library researchers. However, for this to be true, the age of Catherine would need to be wrong (60 versus other estimates that would put her age at about 50 in 1860).
 - Catherine, age 60, from Hesse Darmstadt
 - Lizzie, age 12, born in OH
 - Sophia, age 11, born in OH
 - Mary M, age 6, born in OH

If this second record represents a blending of the Loy family with another, then John's oldest children, John (22) and Catherine (19) are elsewhere. Catherine is married to William Stopher, but I have not found John, who is clearly old enough to be working on his own. This makes sense.

Susannah is not present in either record. Her whereabouts are a mystery. I am inclined to think that Susannah has died at this point, perhaps at the birth of Sarah Ann in about 1864. John has moved west from Marion Co., and, while he does carpentry in Van Wert, he also has property, perhaps through his wife, Catherine, in Jennings township. (There were many Louth families in Jennings Township at the time.)

Let's see whether or not this can play out reasonably with the 1860 and 1870 federal census enumerations for Jennings Twp.

Here is a page from the 1860 census for the same township. It shows the Anthony Louth family. Anthony was a brother to Andrew. The purpose of this is just to demonstrate the presence of another Louth family in the area, near a Hance family.



So, it certainly appears possible that some time after the birth of Mary M. Louth in 1864, the marriage of Andrew and Catherine (Klinger) Louth ended. Catherine then married John in 1865, and they moved in to the farm near other Louth families.

The 1880 Federal Census

As a tribute to John's mobility, I now find a John Loy alone in Lima, Allen Co., OH, as a carpenter. His birth information is wrong, but this may be him. He is a boarder at a hotel.

By this time it makes sense that he would be alone. All children except Sam and Sarah are married, and Sam and Sarah are fending for themselves – Sarah is working in Delphos for sure, but I have not found Sam. (Finding Sam in 1880 is another research goal.)

But, what happened to Catherine? Here is a possible answer, also from the 1880 census. (She is divorced in Van Wert and with daughters Catherine Louth, Linda Louth and Sophia Louth, but she maintains the Loy surname.)

If this is the right person, then the birth date for the divorced Catherine is 1827, not 1810 as would be implied by the 1870 census (noted earlier). Also, the names of the children are not quite the same.

In 1880 we have . . .

- Catherine, age 21
- Sophia, age 20
- Linda, age 17


as opposed to the following in 1860 . . .

- Lizzie, age 12
- Sophia, age 11
- Mary M. 6.

The age differences of the children are believable. Was Catherine (12) in 1860 also known as Lizzie? (I can't find any evidence of this.) Was Mary M. (6) in 1860 known as Linda? For this there are some opinions that she is the same person that married Elias Hinton in Van Wert in 1887 and moved to IN. These opinions list her as Linda Mary Louth or Mary Malinda Louth.

So, John Loy's life in the 1870s and 1880s might have been pretty complicated. Perhaps with patience and perseverance, reality will emerge.

Death




John died in 1892 at the home of his youngest daughter, Sarah, in Delphos. He is buried not far from there.



Here is a map of part of Baden that shows the area where John lived. This map is from the Meyers Gazetteer for the period between about 1871 and 1919. The red pin shows roughly where John and his first wife, Sophia, were married. The births of their first two children, John and Catherine, were both recorded in Würm. Sophia was from Eutingen.



Here is a map of Ohio that shows locations where John lived. This is a map from 1860. The areas of Marion, Van Wert, and Allen Counties where John was present are indicated.



Future Research

Confirm/refute speculation about the identity of a third wife.

Determine what happened to second wife, Susannah.

Find out the details of travel to USA.

Explore the history of people from Baden in Marion County, OH.

Determine what happened to first wife, Sophia. - Resolve the sequence events in the early 1850s to confirm correct dates for Mary's birth and Sophia's death. This should confirm/refute to assumption that Mary is Sophia's daughter.

A research note: If you do research on Loy families, note that, in addition to the families described in this document, there are other families with similar names that may be confusing. Here are some that I have encountered.
