1 Johann Christian & Anna Maria (Zimmer) Selanders

I have found some source information about Christian (elder), but not much about his wife (Anna). Anna Maria's maiden name may have been Zimmer (or Jost/Yost according to some information on ancestry.com). Some people claim that the elder Christian was born in the village of Traben in the Rheinland-Palatinate on 1/5/1754, with a marriage om 6/13/1773 in the same village to Anna Maria. See image 74 of https://www.ancestry.com/discoveryui-content/view/319431:61131 for the record of the marriage. This is why I have use the Zimmer name here, but the writing leaves much to be desired.

Johann Christian's father probably was married at Traben-Trarbach on 4/141750 as well. See image 17 of <u>https://www.ancestry.com/discoveryui-content/view/900321959:61131</u>. The given name of Valentine is probably significant as it recurs among descendants.

1.1 Immigration (1774)

One ancestry entry refers to their immigration in 1774 to Philadelphia on the Minerva from London. They were 22 & 28 years old at the time, meaning that they were born between 1746-1752. 
This record shows that the elder Christian died 12/8/1804 and that the executor for his estate was his son, Valentine. (Son Christian died 2/26/1805, just over a year later, and the executor was Christopher Wunderlich, who I believe was his brother in-law.) He is also present in records of the First Evangelical Lutheran Church in Carlisle, PA.

I have not found a believable death record for Christian's wife, but one person on ancestry.com states that it is 1/11/1795 in PA. This, however, must be weighed against the following record from the 1800 census. It indicates one male over 45 and one female over 45, so Anna Maria may in fact have been alive at this time. It also shows one female under 10 years. Perhaps this was Catherine. Two other children in the list remain unaccounted for (a girl and a boy both between 10 and 15).



I have so far found no unequivocal evidence other than the surname to link Catherine Solander to the family of Christian and Anna Maria. If she is indeed their daughter, she was born rather late in their lives, but not unreasonably so. BTW, I have not found evidence for another Selander/Xylander/Solander family in the area.

I also have found no information about Nathaniel. Jonathan's existence is clearly established, however. Sections that follow show what I have found regarding the children (**Elizabeth**, **Christian**, **Jonathan**, **Valentine**, **Francis**, and **Catherine**).

As a hint, here is an overview of where I believe the six children eventually moved/stayed.



2 Elisabeth (1775-1855)

2.1 Birth


Date inferred indirectly from other sources. She is likely the first child of Christian & Anna Maria.



3.1 Birth (1780?)



Notes for Frederick Wise and Eva Elizabeth Wunderlich

1798 John and Frederick Wise, sons of Jacob Wise and grandsons of Jacob Wise, were named in the will of their grandfather, who died in Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. [1]

1799 Frederick Weise was taxed in South Middleton Twp, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania as a freeman (single, no land). [2] This suggests he was at least age 21 and was born before 1778.

1800 Frederick Wise, farmer, was listed on the septennial census for Middleton Twp, Cumberland County, Pennsylvania. [3]

1801 Eva Elizabeth Wunderlich married Christian Solanders on April 7. Christian Solanders died not long after, in 1804. [4]

1802 Mrs Catherine Wise, wife of Frederick Wise, died in child-birth at age 19 years and 8 weeks. She was buried at the dwelling of her father, Peter Puttaw. [5] Perhaps this is the same Frederick Wise who later married Eva Wunderlich Solander.

1804 Letters of administration were issued to Valentine Solander and David Gray for the estate of Christian Solander, deceased. [6]

1806 Christopher Wonderlich petitioned the Cumberland County Orphans' Court, on May 13, to cite Valentine Salender and David Gray, administrators of the estate of Christian Salendar, deceased, to appear. [7] Widow Elizabeth Salender petitioned the court to appoint guardians for John and Daniel Salender, orphans, under the age of 14, of Christian Salender, deceased. Elizabeth was appointed as guardian. [8] On 9 September, Valentine Selander and David Gray presented the account of the estate of Christian Selander to the Orphans Court, showing a balance of £211. [9]

1806 Mrs Elizabeth Salander [previously Eva Elizabeth Wunderlich] married John Frederick Wise, both of Middleton Twp, Cumberland County, on September 1. [10] [11] [12] [13]

5 Valentine (1783?-1868)

It appears to me that Valentine, his wife (Rachel), and their four children relocated from Cumberland Co., PA, to Marion Co., OH, sometime between 1833 and 1836. This is based on the birth dates and birth locations for his son William's children as shown the the 1850 census for Waldo Co. See "United States Census, 1850," database with images, *FamilySearch* (<u>https://www.familysearch.org/ark:/61903/1:1:MXQL-MVD</u> : 21 December 2020), William Selanders, Waldo, Marion, Ohio, United States; citing family , NARA microfilm publication (Washington, D.C.: National Archives and Records Administration, n.d.).

Valentine and Rachel have their own household until about 1859, when Rachel dies. Shortly thereafter Valentine moves in with daughter Malinda and her husband Sylvester Boyd. Valentine dies in the late 1860s.

I believe that understanding Valentine and his children is central to understanding the Snyders and Culps that lived near each other as shown in the 1850 census. Some supporting information follows.

5.1 Birth (1783?)

No sources found. Year inferred indirectly.

5.2 Marriage (1804-1805?) to Rachel and Subsequent Children

No sources found. Year inferred indirectly. Various places indicate that Valentine's wife was named Rachel Frances Bruce (b. 7/28/1784 in PA), daughter of William A. Bruce and Mary Perciful Lucas, both of Virginia.

5.2.1 William (1806?-1862)

William was born in Cumberland Co., PA, some time between 1805-1807 based on census records. He married Anna Boyer in PA around the year 1830 or somewhat earlier.

Information about Anna follows. Anna's obituary (from findagrave) follows. Cumberland Co., PA, is mentioned. She and her future husband seem to have come to OH with one child between 1833 and 1836 according to the birth years of children mentioned in the 1850 census. This almost exactly parallels John and Catherine Snyder. This and the fact that they lived near each other makes me wonder if they traveled together and perhaps started out together from PA.

Obituaries.

Anna Selanders, nee Boyer, was born May 17, 1809, in Cumberland county, Pa., and died in Waldo, Marion county. O., Feb. 10th, 1892, at the age of 82 years, 8 months and 23 days. Her husband Wm. Selanders preceeded her into eternity 30 years less one day. She was the mother of seven children, six of whom are living. She was a resident of Marion county, 56 years. She was a member of the Evangelical Lutheran church, and although for many years almost deaf, was always as dutiful as strength and health would permit. For a number of years she has been anxious to leave this wretched life on earth to dwell with her Redeemer. The funeral discourse was based on Phil. 1, 21, and preached by Rev D. Simon, in Waldo on Friday, Feb. 12. † JACOB J. WOTTRING. †

Probably in 1833 (est.) William and his family moved with his father, Valentine, and some siblings and their families to Marion Co., OH. Anna and William had the following children that are listed in William's will: Melinda, Alvina, Samuel, Valentine, Mary, Frances Elizabeth, and Sarah. William died in 1862 in Waldo. His probate record exists, lists his surviving children, and indicates that Valentine Coleman (daughter Mary's husband) is his executor.

• **Alvina** (b~1829 in PA) married Jacob Coleman in 1849 in Waldo Twp, and she was buried there in 1914. In 1860, they were living close to her father, William.

- **Samuel** (b.~1831 in PA) married Mariah Miller in 1855 and died probably in Mercer Co., OH, in 1919.
- In 1855 **Melinda** (b.~1833 in PA) married Frederick Ellmaker (Co. C, 145th Ohio Inf.), and she died in 1895 in Waldo Twp.
- Mary (b.~1836 in OH) married Valentine Coleman in Delaware Co., OH, in 1854. Mary and Valentine's marriage is recorded here <u>https://www.familysearch.org/ark:/61903/1:1:X8FM-S7Q</u>.

Valentine Coleman served as executor for William Selanders' estate. Valentine is somewhat older than Mary (by 6 years). - Valentine (b.~1840 in OH): Valentine served in the Civil War (Ohio, 4th Battalion, Company C). He married Amy Emma/Ellen Ayers in about 1870. They lived in Waldo Twp, where they raised their children. His death is given as 1922 in Waldo. See https://www.findagrave.com/memorial/184175454/valentine-e-selanders .
- Frances Elizabeth (b.~1843 in OH) Frances never married. In 1880, she was living with her mother, Anna, in Waldo Twp next to Valentine and Amy (Ayers) Selanders. (<u>https://familysearch.org/ark:/61903/1:1:M89T-WD5</u>) She died 10/1/1890 in Waldo. (<u>https://www.findagrave.com/memorial/91842827/frances-e-selanders</u>)
- Sarah (b.~1848 in OH) Sarah (Ann) probably married Henry Strine 5/5/1870 in Waldo. They appear to have had four children. However, there is confusion in the records between a Sarah born to William and one born to Samuel Selanders (b.1831), William's son. This Sarah died in Waldo in 1912. By the way, Samuel was present in William's house in 1850 and did not marry until 1855. Sarah is also mentioned in William's will in 1862. The 1860 census shows that Samuel did indeed have a daughter named Sarah in about 1860, so there are two Sarahs, but they are 12 years apart in age. Meanwhile, based on the 1870 census and the age of Sarah Strine, I favor the view that William's daughter Sarah married Henry Strine. See https://familysearch.org/ark:/61903/1:1:M6LQ-L7H. Someone will have fun sorting all this out.


5.2.2 Samuel Adam (1817-1871?)

Born about 1817 in PA, Samuel married Sarah Koph in 8/1/1839 in OH and probably died in 1871 in Waldo. This summary (<u>https://www.familysearch.org/tree/person/details/L44D-HQ4</u>) indicates that they had 10 children.

5.2.3 Ellen (Eleanor) (1806-9? - 1903)

Ellen's birth date is estimated from census records, which are not very consistent. 1808 might be a best guess for now. She married Simon Culp on March 20, 1828 in Silver Spring Presbyterian Church.

A biography of Joseph's family is included in a sketch of his son, John Wesley Boyd, published in a county history.15

John Wesley Boyd ... is a son of Joseph and Sarah (Devol) Boyd, both born near the Potomac River in Maryland, who came to Ohio about the year 1814, and located in Licking County, and in 1825 or 1826 came to Marion County and entered eighty acres of land three miles north of Waldo. They subsequently bought 160 acres of land in Pleasant Township, some three or four miles west of their first farm. The father died on the old farm in 1850, and his wife died at the same place four years afterward. They had four children - Edwin, Sylvester, John W. and George. Previous to his marriage to Sarah Devol, he was married to Miss Scott, by whom he had the following children: Joseph, Hiram, William, Eleanor, Ann and Mary, all deceased. He was an old-line Whig in politics, and served the township as Justice of the Peace two terms.

Prospect Twp. -

AUSTIN A. BOYD, farmer, was born in Waldo Township, this county, Jan. 6, 1811, and was the son of Sylvester and Melinda S. (Selanders) Boyd. Mr. Boyd has always been engaged in farming, and is now farming forty acres of the old homestead in Prospect Township, which was bought by his father in 1862. His father died on his farm Jan. 31, 1871, and the widow still resides there. Our subject was married Nov. 2, 1871, to Mary E. Wasser, daughter of Charles Wasser, of Prospect Township. They have three children - Edna May, born Dec. 1, 1874; Charles Carey, Nov. 23, 1876; and Mary E., Aug. 18, 1878. Mr. Boyd is a member of Prospect Lodge, No. 483, I. O. O. F., and in politics, is a Republican.





6.3.2 William (1821-1899)

William was born in Pennsboro Twp, Cumberland County, 2/11/1821. Others as well have found that William married Lucy Lobaugh in 1844 in Carlisle, PA. In 1850 they are in Upper Allen Twp, Cumberland Co. By 1860 the family has started moving west through Illinois, ending up in Kansas. Familysearch shows 13 children! 6.3.3 Elizabeth (1822-1911)

Others have found that Elizabeth was born 10/19/1822 in Shepherdstown, Cumberland Co. She married Samuel Bender in 1844 in Shepherdstown. They had five children and they moved west, ending up in Rock Island, Illinois.

6.3.4 Daniel (1827-1916)

Daniel was born in Cumberland Co., PA, on 9/30/1827. He married Mary Jane McIvor in 1949 in Putnam Co., Illinois. They had a family of five children (all born in IL) and ended their lives divorced and in California. They must have been close to sister Elizabeth for a while as they lived in Rock Island, IL, for a while. Interestingly, the 1900 census indicates that his father was born in Switzerland and his mother in Scotland. This may point to the origins of the Xylander family name.

6.3.5 Ann Jane (1830-1924)

Ann Jane was married in 1848 in Cumberland Co., PA, to Daniel Kline. After Daniel's death, she married Jacob Huber in 1854 in Illinois. They appear to have had six(?) children, and Jane was buried in Rock Island, IL. In 1860, her father Francis lived next to her.

George was born near Shepherdstoen, PA, on 5/14/1838. He married Mary E. Andres in 1867 in Rock Island, IL. They had three children, who all died in the Rock Island area.
