rev. 01, 2/9/2019: This version reflects the completion of an analysis of the female descendants of Hannah Thompson Moultrop through roughly 1800. I added a section to summarize "Undocumented Lines (Dead-ends)". This is where I am collecting a list of research problems that may indicate that more individuals might be found if the problems can be solved.

Rev. 02, 2/10/2019: Information added for Abigail Thompson Alsop and Kezia Moulthrop Barker's lines.

Rev. 02, 2/12/2019: Finished Sarah Thompson's line.

Rev. 03, 2/22/2019: Finished all Thompson lines. This is the first complete draft.

Rev. 04, 2/24/2019: Revised information about Elizabeth Booth, daughter of Esther Osborn Booth. Death information looks very shaky, so turned her death date and location to unknown. Updated info for Lydia Todd Smith – I had missed her daughter Mary (b. 1747).

Rev. 05 3/17/2019: Added information along Mary Pinter's line in an effort to extend that line to provide a proposed connection to a mtDNA cousin. (See the section on Mary Painter Mallory.) I also updated the descendant report at the end of this document.

Objective

Test results from familytreedna.com indicate that my mtDNA is a close match to that of about a dozen people. Taking heteroplasmy into account, some of these may effectively be exact matches. The purpose of the work documented here is to investigate one line of reasoning that might help to identify our most recent common ancestor, who likely lived a few hundred years ago.

There is a chance that our most recent common maternal ancestor existed in the American Colonies. Tracing the female descendants of my first maternal-line female ancestor to appear in colonial records might then identify the common ancestor if others can drive their family trees far enough back in time.

I am lucky to have had the assistance of one of the people with matching mtDNA. This person has traced her maternal line back to Fairfield Co., CT, in the late 1700s, but there is a roadblock at that point. My maternal line starts in the area of New Haven Co., CT, and I have a clear trail of linked ancestors leading back to myself. Perhaps this work will help break the roadblock and help us to determine if our most recent common maternal ancestor lived in England or the American Colonies.

So, this is a description of a quest to identify all direct-line female descendants of a lady probably named Ellen, who lived in Colonial Connecticut. I have not discovered her surname, but it seems that she married a man named John Thompson, and, after his death, she married a man named Thomas Harrison. The second marriage produced no female offspring, but her first marriage did yield female offspring.

By the way, I have found no hints about Ellen's ancestors. I assume that they were from England.

You will not find source references here. This is basically a birth/marriage/death document to establish existence. I am recording some source information in a family tree that I maintain. So, I think that you have to regard what follows as a current estimate, subject to errors and corrections. It is something to work from, not a polished final product.

Following this are best current <u>estimates</u> of the female descendants of Ellen's five daughters. (Note that her second marriage only yielded sons.) My objective is to document the estimated maternal lines into the late 18th century.



The issue of the two Mary's needs to be resolved before anything can be confidently concluded about marriages and offspring.



I can find no evidence that either of her marriages produced children.

Abigail's first husband was Joseph Alsop, whose findgrave memorial (https://www.findagrave.com/memorial/8639056/joseph-alsop_allsup_) reads as follows.

Donald Lines Jacobus's article "Captain John Miles the Weaver, Ancestor of the Wallingford and Goshen, Conn., Families," in The American Genealogist (vol. 35 [October 1959], p. 247-55), established that Capt. John Miles who was buried at Grove Street Cemetery in New Haven

was all but certainly *not* the same man as Capt. John³ Miles, son of John², grandson of Richard¹ Miles, the 1639 emigrant to New Haven from Great Munden, Hertfordshire. Capt. John³ Miles moved to Elizabethtown, New Jersey and died there in 1708.

Capt. John Miles who died 10 Feb 1709/10 and was buried at Grove Street Cemetery was variously called "weaver" and "clothier" in New Haven records. By a first wife whose identity is unknown, he had four sons:

- 1) Maj. Thomas Miles (c1682–1741), m. Abigail Mix
- 2) John Miles (c1684–1760), m. Sarah Ball
- 3) Joseph Miles, presumably the man who m. Jane Bowden 19 Nov 1718 in Newtown, Conn.
- 4) a fourth son whose name is unknown.

By 1694, John Miles the weaver married as his second wife Abigail (Thompson) Alsop, widow of Joseph Alsop, who had died 12 Jan 1690/1.

The Alling family looks to have been popular with Esther as well. She married Roger Alling (1762-1840).

Dorothy Married one Samuel Thomas (b. 1750). Their children included two daughters: Susanah (1790-1795) and Statira (1794-?) - according to a family tree on ancestry.com at least.


Dinah Bristol Candee b. 1751 d. 1785

Eunice Todd Gilbert b. 1732 d. 1832

Eunice may have married John Gilbert (1731?-1779?), but there is some confusion that may stem from the existence of two John Gilberts and/or two wives (Eunice Todd versus Lydia Ives). I was not able to sort out the conflicting views of history.

What I present here is the version in which Eunice Todd married John Gilbert and built a family in New Haven Co., CT, consisting of six children, four of whom were daughters.



Sarah Gilbert (1758-?) - It seems clear that Sarah was a daughter of Eunice and John. However, I can find no clear evidence of her marriage or death. She would be easily confused with Sarah Gilbert (b. 9/9/1758) to Hezekiah Gilbert and his with Tameson Gregory in Fairfield Co., CT. More research could be done on this.

Eunice Gilbert (1762-1835) married Jesse Tuttle (1759-1848). I did not look for any offspring that they may have produced.




The marriage of Dinah Sherman and James Atwater looks like the right one to follow in this case.

Sarah, Mary, Abigail, Hannah, and Rebecca.



Sarah Cooper Munson b. 1673 d. 1736

married in New Haven in 1692 and had daughters Hannah, Amy, Ruth, Mehitabel, Sarah, and Elizabeth.



Hannah Munson Andrews b. 1697 d. 1785

It appears that Hannah was the last wife (the first being Lydia Johnson?) of Gideon Andrews They may have married in 1739, and they may have had one child – Samuel (1742-?). I suspect that this branch of the mtDNA trail ends here.

Amy Munson Sperry b. 1704 d. ?

Amy married Joshua Sperry in about 1727 in New Haven. Their children seem to have included the following daughters – Rebecca (1730-?), Amy (1732-1748), Phebe (1735-1756), Sarah (1739-1740), Thankful (1740/1741-?), and Rachel (1746-1748). the ones that might have had children are analyzed below.

Rebecca Sperry Osborn b. 1730 d.?

Rebecca Sperry married Jehiel Osborn (1728-?). They in turn had the following daughters –

- Amy (1750/1751-1761) did not live long enough to produce offspring.
- Rachel (1755-?) who married Michael Kenney,
- Lucy (1758-?) who married Zophar Atwater,

- Rebecca (1764-1842) who married Elijah Hotchkiss,
- and Elizabeth (1772-?) who married Harmon Payne.

Amy Sperry b. 1732 d. 1748

Amy Sperry likely died in 1748 at about the age of 16. She shared a birthday (6/10) with her sister, Rebecca. I have found no marriage records, so I will assume that she had no children.

Phebe Sperry Downs b. 1735 d.?

Phebe married Joseph Downs in 1756. They had a family in new haven Co., CT. All children but two were male. One female was Phebe (1765-1844) and the other was Candace (1756-?). Both daughters married men with the surname of Downs (!) and stayed in the New Haven area.

Thankful Sperry b. 1740 d. 1740?

I have found just the records of birth and baptism, separated by about 2 months. Other than this, there is no trace. I have a suspicion that this child did not survive long.

Ruth Munson Hotchkiss b. 1708 d. 1785

Ruth married Caleb Hotchkiss in 1728 in New Haven. They had four children, one of whom was a daughter – Esther (b.1745).

Esther Hotchkiss Murray b. 1745 d. 1831

Esther married Philemon Murray and they had just one son, Hezekiah. This myDNA line ends here.

Mehitabel Munson Morris b. 1709

Benjamin Munson (b. 1699) married Mehitabel in November of 1731. They had three children – two of whom were female.

Sarah Morris b. 1737 d. 1829?

Sarah married Judah Thompson and probably had just two children. One one a daughter named Rebecca Thompson (b. 1760). I can find no record of a marriage for this Rebecca, but I did find a potential death record – from phthisis (!) in 1829 in New Haven. I am inclined to accept this in lieu of other evidence. Taking that assumption, this branch of the mtDNA line end here.

Elizabeth Morris Humpreville b. 1739 d.?

It appears that in 1759 Elizabeth Morris married Thomas Humphreville (b. 1736) in New Haven Co., CT. Their children were Lemuel (1760-?), Thomas (1762-1850), Elijah (1764-?), Elizabeth (1766-1825) who married Ezra Lines (1760-1820), and Mehitabel (1770-1806) who apparently was never married.

Sarah Munson Stone b. 1713 d. 1737

Sarah married Enos Stone in 1731 and they had two children – Daniel (b. 1732) and Elizabeth (b. 1735).

Elizabeth Stone b. 1735 d.?

I can find no record of what might have happened to Elizabeth. There are some potentially confusing similarly named people at this point in time. This is a line that could be investigated further.

Elizabeth Munson Perkins b. 1695 d. ?

Elizabeth married Seth Perkins (1685-1733) in 1716. Their children were Thomas (b. 1717), Amy and Eleanor.

Amy Perkins Peck b. 1726 d. 1799

Amy married Joseph Peck (1718-1788) in New haven. Their family consisted of the following. They mostly lived in the area of Woodbridge, CT.

Bathsheba Peck (1745-1832), who probably married Roswell Palmer (b. 1742)

Seth Peck (1747-1831)

Joseph Peck (1749-1800), who married Sarah Allcock (b. 1749)

Amy Peck (b.1751) who married Wilmot Bradley (1751-1814)

Dan Peck (b.1753)

John Peck (1756-1825), who married Lois Osborne.

Dorcas Peck (b.1758), who probably married William Osborne (b.1755).

Asenath Peck (1760-1838), who married Stephen Russell (1756-1817)

Electa Peck (b.1761), who married John Alling (b.1761).



Rhoda Peck (1768-1770)

Eleanor Perkins Hotchkiss b. 1726 d. 1816

Eleanor married Solomon Hotchkiss (b.1724?) and lived in Woodbridge, CT. They had one daughter and two sons named Solomon (1752-1793) and David (1754-1823). Their daughter was Elizabeth Hotchkiss (b. 1749). Elizabeth married Daniel Johnson (b.1749).

Mary Cooper Smith b. 1677 d. 1761 *



Obedience Smith b. 1705 d. 1705

The consensus among researchers is that Obedience died not long after birth in New Haven.

Mary Smith Painter b. 1707 d. 1786

Mary married one Deliverance Painter (1701-1781) on 6/23/1775 in New Haven. There is a sad story about the death of Deliverance that you can see at his memorial -

https://www.findagrave.com/memorial/66645028 .Their family consisted of the following, including five daughters. Of these five, it appears that only one (Mary) had any children. The family lived in New Haven Co., CT.

Mary Painter Mallory b. 1728 d. 1804

Mary married Daniel Mallory (1720-?) in New Haven. It appears that they relocated to Litchfield Co., CT, where they had a large family that included the following daughters.

Abigail Mallory Curtiss (1748-?): Abigail married Israel Curtiss (1742-1802). They may have had a fairly large family, and they may have moved into Saratoga Co., NY. Their daughters included Polly (b. 1771), Charlotte (b. 1773), Mary (b. 1776), and Alathea (b.1785).

Mary Mallory Curtiss (1749-10-17-?): I believe that Mary (like her sister) married a Curtiss (Stephen Curtiss 1744-1813) in Litchfield Co., CT. They also had a fairly large family, but most members stayed in CT. Her daughters included Amey (b. 1774), Mabel (b. 1778), Abigail (b. a780), Betsy (b.1783), Laura (b. 1790), and Louisa (b. 1792).

Note that there are two people named Mary Mallory/Mellery, living geographically very close (in Litchfield Co., CT), who are within a a year of each other in age. The other Mary Mallory (b. 1748-06-23) was the daughter of John Mallory and probably Mary Sanford. She may have married a Simeon Minor (b. 1743) – who was also shadowed by a person with the same name in the same location but born about 7 years later.

Freelove Amy Osborne (1752-1794): Married Jared Osborne (1745-1832). They had four children, and their family stayed in the Oxford area of New Haven Co., CT. There was one daughter named Electa (b. 1793).

Lois Mallory Chatfield (1756-1790?): Lois married Eli Chatfield (1754-1840) in Oxford, New Haven, CT. There were six children, one of whom (Sherman) may have made it to Illinois. The daughters included Mary (b. 1778), Obedience (b. 1782), Lucinda (b. 1784), and Polly (b.1788).

Adah Mallory (Hitchcok?) (1762-?): There is confusion among researchers about who Adah may have married. – For now I choose Caleb Hitchcock, but that should be confirmed. If this is true, then their children included the following daughters: Polly, Huldah, Leusinia, Esther, Adah, and Phila.

Rebecca Mallory Osborne (1764–1846): There is evidence that Rebecca married Nathan Orborne (1763-1845). They may have had a large family and at some point moved to NY. This is worthy of more research.

Mabel Mallory (1765-?): I can find no clear evidence regarding what became of Mabel. It is clear that she was born on 11/17/1765 to Daniel and Mary in Litchfield Co., CT.

Pene Mallory (1767-?): It is clear that Pene was born on 9/9/1767 to Daniel and Mary in Litchfield, but I can find no evidence about the rest of her life.

Amy Painter b. 1730 d. 1751

Died unmarried at only 21 years of age. She is buried in West Haven, New Haven, CT.

Abigail Painter b. 1738 d. 1755

Died unmarried at only 16 years of age. She is buried with her sister in West Haven.

Rebecca Painter b. 1744 d. 1788

I have seen in ancestry.com that there is suspicion that Rebecca married John Sherman (1734-1803). The evidence does appear to be strong, but if it is correct, they had just one child — Nathan Sherman (1767-1857). See https://www.ancestry.com/family-tree/person/tree/151746240/person/342011163400/facts? phsrc=VqT14& phstart=successSource . This is the only hint that I have had about Rebecca's life.

Freelove Painter b. 1749 d. 1751

This child died at about age 2 in West Haven, New Haven Co., CT.

Amy Smith b. 1709 d. ?

It is clear that Amy was born 3/10/1709 in New Haven to Samuel Smith and Mary Cooper Smith. There is speculation that she died in 1709, or before 1715, or Her actual fate is unknown based on the evidence that I have seen. More work might be useful here.

Margaret Smith Smith(!) b. 1711 d. 1803 *

Here the trail is much clearer. Margaret married Austin Smith (1711-1797) in New Haven, CT, on 2/7/1733. They share one set of great grandparents, namely George Smith (1618-1662) and his wife Sarah Bourne (1614-1683), so they were second cousins. Their offspring are listed below and the daughters' families are examined in following sections.

Margaret Smith Thompson b. 1734 d. 1821

Margaret married Jonathan Thompson (1733-1784) in New haven Co., CT. Some researchers think that Jonathan's line can be traced back to the John Thompson that was Ellen's husband. There was another John Thompson in New Haven at the same time, however, and it seems more likely that this Jonathan Thompson's line leads back to him and his wife, Dorothy. This needs clarification, however. DNA analysis might ultimately be needed to separate of the Thompson lines (assuming that the two John Thompsons were not related).

In any event, Margaret and Jonathan had four children – Stephen (1759-?), Esther (1766-?), and Mary (?-1829).

Mary Thompson married David Hopkins. They lived in the Waterbury, CT, area and had a family that probably consisted of seven children, including three daughters (Polly, Mabel, and Laura).

Mary Smith (Thompson?) b. 1737 d. 1773

There is speculation that Mary married Joel David Thompson (1737-1804). If that is the case, then there are a number of daughters to consider. This is VERY tentative, however.



Hannah Smith Hickox b. 1746/1747 d.?

There is speculation that Hannah (1746-?) married James Hickox(k) (1746-1833) on 11/28/1766 in New Haven. They may have had a daughter named Olive (1744-1806), who married a man named John Bouton.

Philena Smith Hickox b. 1750 d. 1826 *

In the context of autosomal DNA matching results, Philena's family represents a likely practical limit to which autosomal DNA matching could be expected to yield a match worth pursuing. Someone descended from one of her children could theoretically share about 0.1% of autosomal DNA with me or my mother. The statistical nature of inheritance, however, means that a living person who shares a most recent common ancestor from this family may share no DNA or a little more than 0.1%.



occurred on 8/29/1771 in Waterbury, New haven, CT.

There is evidence for just four children, all born in Waterbury. However, the family moved to Chenango Co., NY at some point. Chenango Co. is where Gideon and Philena are buried.

The families of their daughters and son are investigated below.

Sarah Hickox Beebe b. 1774 d. 1864

Sarah married Orillana Beebe (1770-1863), probably in CT. His name is spelled in an assortment of ways. They moved to Cortland Co., NY, and probably had quite a few children. Sarah and Orillana are both buried there.

Polly Hickox Warner b. 1777 d. 1849 *

Polly married Richard Warner while still in Waterbury in about 1792. They must have moved with her parents sometime between 1792 and 1802 based on the birth records for their children. My direct line maternal ancestor, Electa was born in Chenango Co., on 2/2/1802. It is her marriage to John Edwin

Robbins Jr. that produces the first first family for which I have some pictures. This Robbins/Warner family lived in Crawford Co., PA.

Hannah Smith Hickox Terrill b. 1781 d. 1856

Hannah married Elias Terrill (1766-1835) in New haven Co., CT, on 5/6/1798. They probably had a large family – some born in CT and others born in NY. (They eventually moved to Chenango Co., NY.

David Hickox b. 1772 d. 1847

David married Kezia Dutton (1783-1865), They lived in Litchfiedl Co., CT, and they had one son named Caleb.

Mehitabel Smith Benham b. 1755 d. 1834

Mehitabel married Elihu Benham (1748-1836). They lived in New haven Co., CT, and they had a family consisting of the following children (or something close to this?). (There is disagreement about the children.) Once again, this was a New Haven Family.

- Mehitabel (1773-?): married Zebah Farrell (1776-1862), had a family and remained in the New Haven Co., CT, area.
- Sally (1775-1862): She may have died 2/19/1862 in New Haven Co., CT. And, she may have been married to one Jacob Monroe on 3/12/1793.
- Elihu (1777-1862)
- Laurena (1785?-?): unknown fate.
- Leverett (1799-1851)
- Ransom (1790-1860)
- Philena (1791-?): unknown fate.
- Barzil (1795-1878)
- Lewis (1796-1885)
- Desire (1798-1803)


The information for this family is VERY tentative and could benefit form more research.

Thankful Smith Tolles b. 1712 d. 1769


Thankful married Daniel Tolles (1705-1782) probably in the early 1730s. (Some people have confused her with her daughter, Thankful Tolles, who married Daniel Sanford.)

Thankful Smith and Daniel Tolles lived in New Haven Co., CT, where they may have had an impressive array of children. Estimates include the list of twelve in the accompanying picture.

Assuming this list is correct, there were four daughters to investigate: Thankful, Dorothy, Desire, and Mary.



Thankful Tolles Sanford b. 1737 d. 1820



Irenah Sanford (1753-1830?): Irenah probably married Samuel Fenn (1743-1820) in 1767. There are multiple Samuel Fenns around at about this time, but this appears to be the correct one. That being the case, their children were likely included . . . Irena (1768-1830), Samuel (1770-1854), Eli (1772-1822), Thankful (1776-1829), and Anna (1778-?). Litchfield Co., CT, looks to have been their final home area.

Thankful Sanford (1755-1759): This Thankful did not survive long enough to have offspring.

Lois Sanford (1760-1832): Lois married Daniel Curtis (1754-1803) in 1776. They lived in Litchfield Co., CT, and had three children – Polly (1782-?), who married Isaac Newton (I did not make that up.), Eli (1786-?), and Philena (1779-?).

Phebe Sanford (1762-?): Phoebe married Samuel Martin (1759-?). They started in CT and eventually ended up in Broome Co., NY. Their children included these daughters: Fanny, Phebe, and Charlotte.

Dorothy Tolles b. 1745 d. 1745?

I find nothing other than a record of Dorothy's baptism on 12/8/1745 in Nrew Haven Co., CT. My suspicion is that Dorothy was a twin to Desire and that Dorothy did not survive.

Desire Tolles Beecher b. 1745 d. 1812

Desire married Isaac Beecher on 4/28/1768. They had a large family that included the following daughters Frances, Elizabeth, and Betsy. Some children, as well as Isaac ended up in Litchfield Co., CT.

Mary Tolles Thomas b. 1756 d. 1842

Mary married Noah Thomas (1756-1818) in Oxford, CT., on 9/8/1781. They had six children, only one of which was female, namely Laura, who may have married Elihu Roninson.

Abigail Cooper Johnson b. 1679 d. 1724



Eunice Johnson (Sperry?) b. 1703 d. 1725


Eunice died quite early in life (age 22). Only one source indicates that she may have married Asa Sperry, but I can find no confirmation of this. For now, I assume that Eunice died "without issue."

Kezia Lines Alling b. 1715 d. 1782

Kezia (1715-1782) married Samuel Alling (1712/1715-1799) in about 1737 in New Haven. Their children consisted of those in the accompanying picture.



Ruth Alling Hine b. 1738 d. 1777

Daughter Ruth married Daniel Hine (1734-1798). Their daughters were Mary (1757-?), Kezia (1759-?), Rebecca (1760-?), Eunice (1760-?), Elizabeth (1765-?), and Hannah (1767-?). The history of this family seems a little confusing and poorly defined. The daughters warrant more research.

I have not found more data about Mary Hine (b. 1757). She deserves more research.

It appears that Kezia Hine married Timothy Goodrich (1756-1829). They ended up in VT.

Rebecca Hine (b. 1760) may have married a Hubbard person and moved to VT. She seems to buried next to her sister, Elizabeth, in Rutland Co., VT. See memorial: https://www.findagrave.com/memorial/46521466/elizabeth-hine.

Eunice Hine (b. 1760) seems to have married Jonathan Orms. They lived in Rutland Co.,VT, and had a large family.

Elizabeth Hine likely was not married and died in VT. See info about her sister Rebecca above.

Kezia Alling b. 1748 d. 1765

Daughter Kezia(h) died at about the age of 17 so I assume that she did not marry and so had no children. She was Cornelius' twin sister.

Eleanor Alling Frisbie b. 1751 d.?

Eleanor married Amos Frisbie. They lived in New Haven.

Hannah Alling Peck b. 1751 d.?

Hannah married Seth Peck. They also lived in the New Haven area. We have seen the Peck name elsewhere.


Phebe Alling Talmadge Wolcott b. 1723 d. 1788


Sarah Utter (b.1730), daughter of Lydia Russell (b. 1692) and Abraham Utter (b. 1688)

There is conflicting information about the fate of Sarah. She may have died within a year of birth or she may have married Phillip Knight of Rhode Island, where she died in 1759, after having two daughters – Phebe (b. 1756) and Sarah (b. 1757). Requires more careful research to get a better idea of the truth.



Abigail Hodges (b. 1731), daughter of Abigail Russell (b. 1701) and Abraham Hodges (b. 1697)

I have found nothing other than a birth record, so she warrants more research.



First Daughter of Sarah Shepard Chidsey (b.1728), Hannah Chidsey (b. 1747)

I have been unable to trace much information for this individual. There is a reference to Dodd's East Haven (register?) to indicate a death in 1840! More work is needed here to get a clear picture, if possible.

Sarah Chidsey (b. 1758), daughter of Sarah Shepard (b. 1728) and John Chidsey (b. 1720)

Sarah appears to have Chidsey, John been married to 1720-09-15 + 1783-09-17 Richard Barrett in East haven, CT, on 1/13/1780. However, Chidsey, Sarah it is not clear whether m. 1745-12-21 1758-10-20 they had children. In fact it is not at all Shepard, John clear that this is a 1696-08-09 + 1780-05-18 correct association. More investigation is Shepard, Sarah 1728-03-11 required. Russell, John + 1783-06-01 1664-12-14 + 1724-02-13 Russell, Sarah * 1711-02-23 m. 1687-08-17 + 1761-01-01 Moulthrop, Hannah Moulthrop, Matthew 1665-04-20 m. 1662-06-26 + 1713-01-30

Rhoda Chidsey (b. 1764), daughter of Sarah Shepard (b. 1728) and John Chidsey (b. 1720)

Thompson, Hannah

Rhoda may have married William Seymour and ended up in Delaware Co., NY. If so, she had daughters. However, all that is available online that I can find appears to be hearsay. More work is needed here.

Mary Shepard's Identity(ies)

I am afraid that there is confusion in the ranks over two families - one headed by Mary Shepard and David Grannis, offspring of Russell and Lydia (Forbes) Grannis and Thomas and Sarah (Hotchkiss) Shepard. The children of this marriage are often listed with the sames names as the one from the other marriage - that being between Sarah Russell (daughter of John and Sarah (Russell) Shepard) and the same David Grannis.

The issue of the two Mary's needs to be resolved before anything can be confidently concluded about marriages and offspring.



Esther Palmer (b. 1751), daughter of Lydia Barker Palmer (b. 1712)

I have been unable to locate any information other a birth record for this individual, who was born in Branford, CT.



Along Rebecca Thompson's Line

Elizabeth / Betsy Booth b. 1753

Daughter Esther had just a daughter, Elizabeth – born in Fairfield Co., CT. However there is confusion in the compiled records about another daughter named Betsy, who might actually be Elizabeth. If they are the same person, she likely married Hezekiah Sanford (?-1834?) and eventually died in Hartford Co., CT.

Sarah Gilbert (1758-?)

It seems clear that Sarah was a daughter of Eunice Todd and John Gilbert. However, I can find no clear evidence of her marriage or death. She would be easily confused with Sarah Gilbert (b. 9/9/1758) to Hezekiah Gilbert and his with Tameson Gregory in Fairfield Co., CT. More research could be done on this.

Her birth family in fact is somewhat uncertain because of research confusion. There is some confusion that may stem from the existence of two John Gilberts and/or two wives (Eunice Todd versus Lydia Ives). I was not able to sort out the conflicting views of history.

Mary Peck b. 1758 d. ?

I can find no clear records for Mary other than the record of her birth in New Haven Co., CT. More research is needed.

Pamela Peck b. 1761 d. ?

I can find no clear records for Pamela. Just one pedigree submission mentions her. - "Pedigree Resource File," database, *FamilySearch* (https://familysearch.org/ark:/61903/2:2:SBQK-7FM: accessed 15 February 2019), entry for Pamela /Peck/; file (2:2:2:MM7Y-Z63), submitted 14 May 2011 by shalom [identity withheld for privacy].

Mary Dinah Peck b. 1767

I can find no clear records for this Mary other than the record of her birth, which shows her name as Mary Dinah. More research is needed.

Along Mary Thompson's Line

Elizabeth Stone b. 1735 d.?

I can find no record of what might have happened to Elizabeth. This is a line that could be investigated further.

Mary (1757? -?), the Daughter of Ruth Alling Hine b. 1738 d. 1777

Daughter Ruth married Daniel Hine (1734-1798). Their daughters were Mary (1757-?), Kezia (1759-?), Rebecca (1760-?), Eunice (1760-?), Elizabeth (1765-?), and Hannah (1767-?). The history of this family seems a little confusing and poorly defined. The daughters warrant more research.

I have not found more data about Mary Hine (b. 1757). She deserves more research.

It appears that Kezia Hine married Timothy Goodrich (1756-1829). They ended up in VT.

Rebecca Hine (b. 1760) may have married a Hubbard person and moved to VT. She seems to buried next to her sister, Elizabeth, in Rutland Co., VT. See memorial: https://www.findagrave.com/memorial/46521466/elizabeth-hine.

Eunice Hine (b. 1760) seems to have married Jonathan Orms. They lived in Rutland Co.,VT, and had a large family.

Elizabeth Hine likely was not married and died in VT. See info about her sister Rebecca above.

Eunice Johnson (Sperry?) b. 1703 d. 1725

Eunice died quite early in life (age 22). Only one source indicates that she may have married Asa Sperry, but I can find no confirmation of this. For now, I assume that Eunice died "without issue." However, this could be investigated. There may be another mtDNA line here.

Rebecca Painter (Sherman?) b. 1744 d. 1788

I have seen in ancestry.com that there is suspicion that Rebecca married John Sherman (1734-1803). The evidence does appear to be strong, but if it is correct, they had just one child – Nathan Sherman (1767-1857). See https://www.ancestry.com/family-tree/person/tree/151746240/person/342011163400/facts? phsrc=VqT14& phstart=successSource. This is the only hint that I have had about Rebecca's life. Given the lack of certainty, more research me be worthwhile.

Amy Smith b. 1709 d.?

It is clear that Amy was born 3/10/1709 in New Haven to Samuel Smith and Mary Cooper Smith. There is speculation that she died in 1709, or before 1715, or Her actual fate is unknown based on the evidence that I have seen. More work might be useful here.

Mary Smith (Thompson?) b. 1737 d. 1773

There is speculation that Mary married Joel David Thompson (1737-1804). If that is the case, then there are a number of daughters to consider. This is VERY tentative, however.
